



Live streaming of the Midday Service to YouTube from that location. Everyone can attend at this time, but registration is still needed on the Mount Gilead website.





Rest Continued

The best quality of sleep is during the hours before midnight. For best sleep, bedtime should be no later than 10 p.m. We sleep best if our stomach can also rest from its work of digestion-at least 3 hours after eating.

Recipe for Restful Sleep

- A quiet, dark, well-ventilated room
- An empty stomach (3 hours after eating)
- Moderate physical activity before retiring
