8. Thank you for your time. I will call you back soon. God bless you and your family!

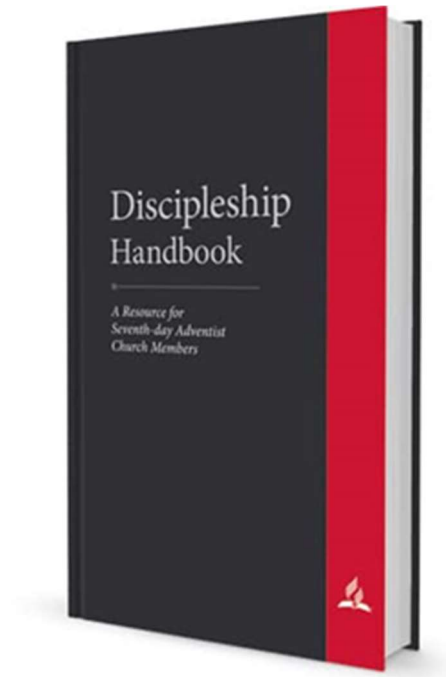

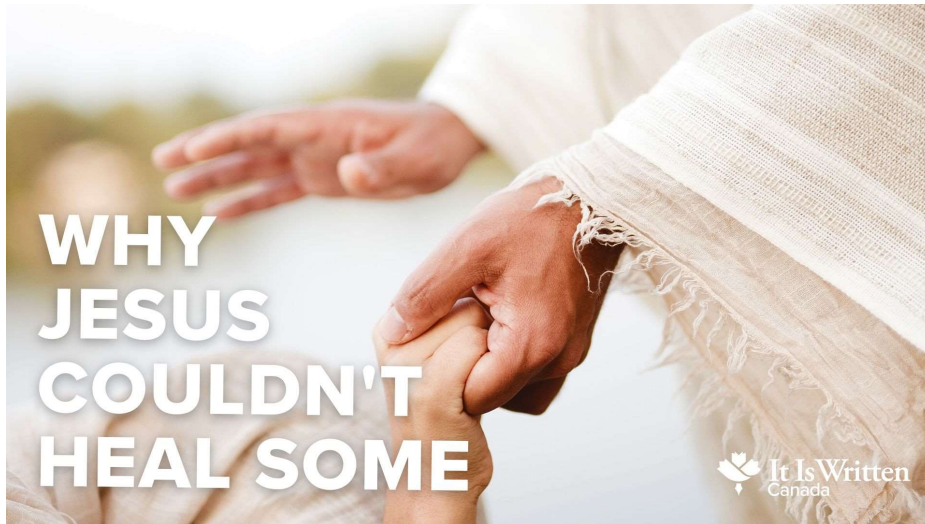
The Bible tells us that Jesus “could do NO mighty work” in some places, especially among His own people (Mark 6:5). He could not lay His hands on their sick and heal them.
