





Testimony

It was on Monday, January 9, 2023, at 4:00 a.m. my husband complained about his chest pain when the pain started to gradually increase. He drove his car to the family doctor, but the doctor was on leave so the receptionist said, "You need to go to the emergency". He parked his car near the shops and walked to the Scarborough General Hospital. Soon the nurse came and did his ECG and got him admitted. The next day they sent him to the Centenary Hospital for his Angio and found that he had four blockages in his heart. The doctor said you must go for a bypass. It was very shocking to all of us. For seven days he was in Scarborough Hospital under observation. I said to myself, "Oh Lord who will help us now? What are we going to do?" All we could do was to be beside him and give moral support.


That night when my children and I reached home, before going to bed, I opened my phone to check any messages and as I was scrolling, I could see beautiful Bible verses. I read Matthew 21:22 which says, "If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer." After a few days, the surgery date was fixed. On January 15 from Scarborough Hospital, he was transferred to St. Michael's Hospital. Everything was prepared for the next day's surgery. We prayed and let the nurse take him inside. The surgery was six hours. As soon as the surgery was done the doctor called me on the phone and said, "The surgery was successful, everything will be alright." That evening he was brought to the ICU Unit. We all stood beside his bed. He was fast asleep. I asked his nurse "When will he come out of his anesthesia?" She said, "It will take at least three to four hours." I told the nurse, "Please let him know that his wife and children were here but left because the visiting hours were closed." The nurse said, "When he wakes up, he will not remember anything." I said to her, "it's Ok. Everything will be fine," and we left the hospital.

That night as usual I was scrolling on my phone, and I came across this Bible verse in Isaiah 38:5 It says, "I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will add fifteen years to your life...."

These two powerful Bible verses gave us hope. We were strong enough to stay positive. We look up and thank God for his life, his grace and mercy. My children and I would like to thank the St. Michael's Hospital and their staff for the good care and treatment that my husband received during and after his surgery. Our only prayer is that the coming year 2024 be filled with peace, prosperity, love and good health.
