Health Corner

For those of you who missed our health presentation on insomnia last Thursday, here are four tips that may help you achieve a good night's sleep.



1. Manage Stress

Practice stress-reducing techniques such as deep breathing and prayer. Chronic stress can contribute to insomnia.

2. Establish a Consistent Sleep Schedule

Go to bed and wake up at the same time every day, even on weekends. This helps regulate your body's internal clock.

3. Be Mindful of Food and Drink

Avoid heavy meals close to bedtime. Additionally, limit your fluid intake before bedtime to minimize the need for bathroom trips during the night.

4. Limit Screen Time Before Bed

Reduce exposure to screens (phones, computers, TVs) at least an hour before bedtime. The blue light emitted from screens can disrupt the production of the sleep hormone melatonin.
